



How to adjust a Harmony Harness

Fitting a puppy:

When measuring a puppy for their new Harmony Harness, the harness is to be measured at its smallest so that the harness has maximum use with a growing puppy.

STEP 1

The black adjusters are to be at the same length each side, taken all the way into the metal rings. This is to be done for both the chest (colour) and back (black).



STEP 2

The girth adjuster is to be take all the way into the buckle.



STEP 3

After all the adjustments have been made with the harness fitted onto the puppy at the smallest possible size, the lead attaches to the front of the harness with the clasp going through both metal hoops.





Fitting an adult dog:

Adult dogs are to be fitted with a harness that sits on the dog firmly and securely. Two fingers maximum should fit under the back & girth.

STEP 1

For both the back and the chest, the adjusters are to be equal length each side. The girth is to be adjusted where required for the dog.



STEP 2

The chest fits over the breast bone of the dog, it shouldn't be loose or hanging down. The lead attaches to the front of the harness with the clasp going through both metal hoops.





How to Fit a Harmony Harness

STEP 1

Place your hand through the Harmony Harness so that the black back strap with the single ring is resting on your arm, the coloured front chest straps with the two rings should be facing your elbow.



STEP 2

With a treat in the same hand that is holding the harness, get your dog focused on nibbling at the treat and while your dog is busy use your other hand to slip the harness over your dogs head and in place.



STEP 3

Drop a couple of treats onto the ground, while your dog is focused on the treats reach under the dog and grasp the belly strap and do up the clip.





STEP 4

Now you should now be ready to attach the lead to the two rings at your dog's chest. The single ring on the back is for the car attachment to be clipped to. Always attach your lead to two rings at the dog's chest not the single ring at the back of your dog. Have fun walking your dog!
